

The Further Mathematics Support Programme is pleased to announce three online revision sessions during May aimed at students who are targeting an A or A* grade in their GCSE Mathematics this summer. **These are free to attend for any student or teacher in an FMSP registered school.** Similar sessions were provided last year and they received excellent feedback.

The sessions will include

- a brief and informal multiple choice test review of B/C grade material in each topic;
- a look at some examination questions covering A/A* grade material;
- a review of marks schemes; brief opportunities for participants to consider exam questions themselves.

Details of the sessions are given below. To access the sessions, participants need to follow the appropriate link about 10 minutes before the start. There is no booking procedure, all that is needed to access these sessions is a computer connected to the internet and an audio output facility. (Speakers/Headphones.)
